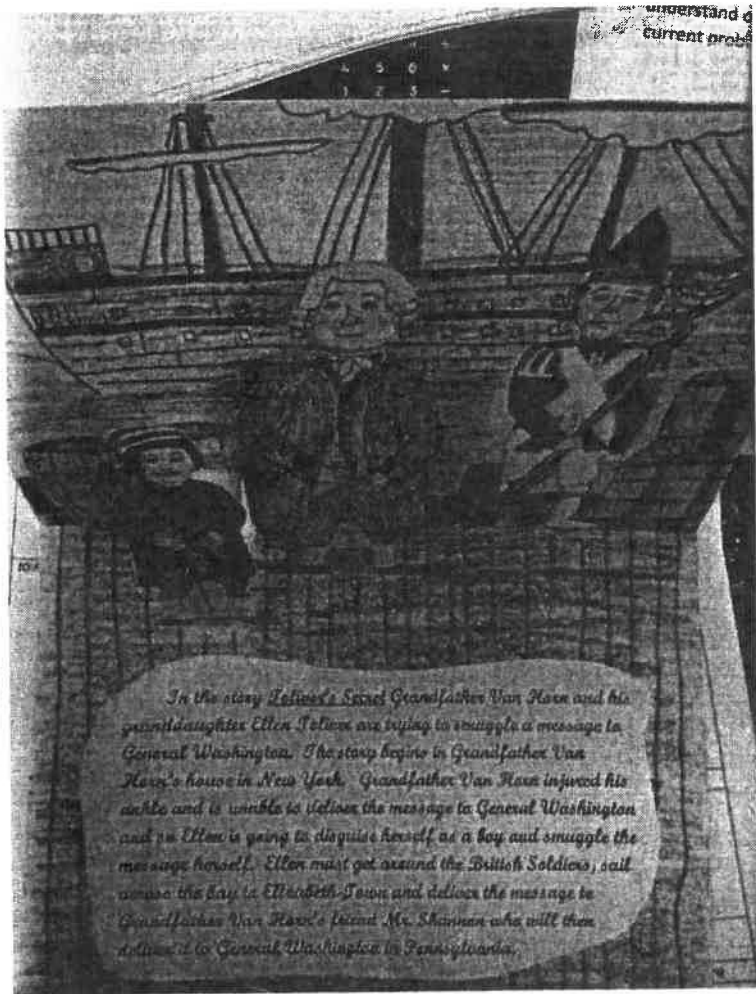


Make Your Own Pop-up Book

Students can provide their own paper or ask the teacher for paper from school to complete this project. Follow the directions below to create a pop-up book.

1. Draw a rough sketch of a scene important in the first third of your book and decide which parts of the sketch will "pop up".
2. Fold a piece of white construction paper (ask your teacher) or card stock paper in half horizontally (hamburger style).
3. To make each pop-up tab Leave your paper folded and cut two slits along the folded edge. You will need to cut two slits for every item you want to pop up. If you make the slits different lengths your pop ups will sit farther out in the page or closer to the fold.
4. Open the paper up, and gently pull each of the pop-up tabs forward.
5. Fold the paper again so that each of the pop-up tabs falls into the center. Make a crease at the base of each tab.
6. Open the paper up and illustrate the background. Don't color the pop up tabs or the glue won't stick very well.
7. On a separate sheet of paper, draw the pop-up elements of your scene. Cut the elements out and glue them to the front of a tab.
8. Type a short summary for the first third of the book which includes the setting, characters, and problem. **The summary MUST be typed.** If you do not have a computer at home it will be your responsibility to find time at school to type it.





9. You will follow steps 1-8 for page two which should summarize the middle of your chapter book. The summary must include the climax or plot of the story.
10. Follow steps 1-8 for page three which should summarize the end of your chapter book. The summary must include the resolution and conclusion of the story.

Finishing the book:

11. Bind your book together by gluing the bottom of page one to the top of page two. Make sure you don't put glue where the pop up tabs are or they won't pop up and may tear the page. Then glue the ottom of page two to the top of page three, again be careful where you put your glue.
12. Make a cover for your book by gluing a large sheet of construction paper from the top of page one, over the fold, and the bottom of page 3.
13. Add a title and a cover illustration. Color the illustration. Don't forget to write the type of Genre the story is on the front cover also.
